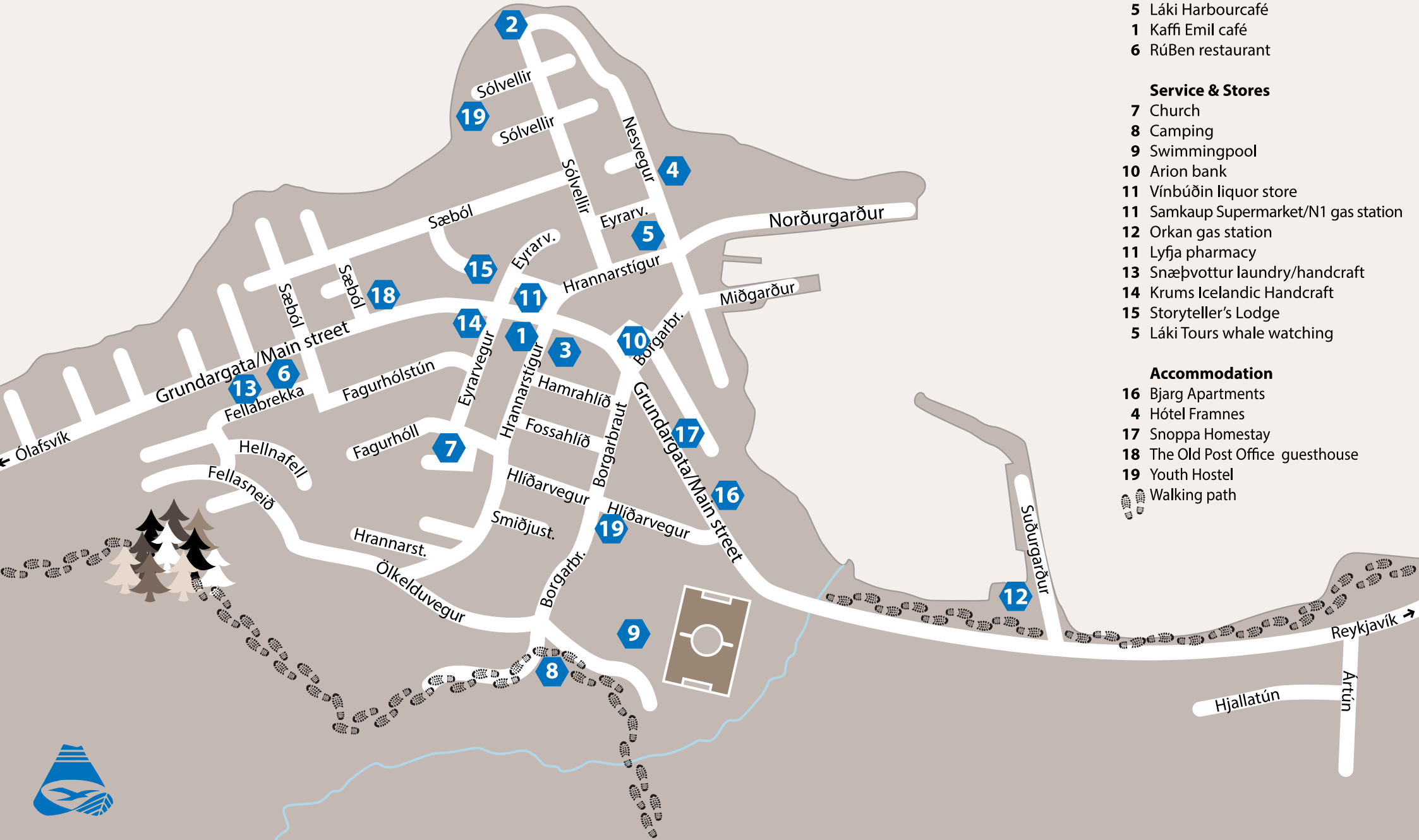


Grundarfjörður - Town map

SNÆFELLSNES PENINSULA

This 90- km long peninsula comprises a world of diversity. Friendly towns and villages, spectacular mountains, a multitude of bird species nesting on treacherous cliffs, beaches of sand and pebbles popular among horsemen and rock skimmers, remnants and relics scattered here and there of times and ways of life long past. Saga sites and hiking trails.

The Snæfellsjökull National Park is at the westernmost part of the peninsula, including the mystical glacier Snæfellsjökull, as well as other unique sites such as Djúpalónssandur, Þúfubjarg and more.

GRUNDARFJÖRÐUR

Grundarfjörður is a growing community on the fjord Breiðafjörður near the midpoint of the northern coast of Snæfellsness peninsula. The site is characterized by a unique climate and unusually beautiful surroundings. The town is mostly known for the beautiful Mt. Kirkjufell which is one of the most photographed mountains in Iceland. Fishing is the chief industry in Grundarfjörður, although the tourist industry has been growing for the last years.
